Dear Herb:

This will confirm our conversation of August 11th, precipitated by Dave Baldwin's letter of August 7th to Mr. Steiner at the Underwriters' Laboratories.

I discussed this with Mr. Briber by telephone to determine the mechanics of arranging for the transfer of the labels on Micarta to Westinghouse. Mr. Briber was of the opinion that it was best to let the investigation continue as now set up and that, after the program is concluded, a transfer could be arranged so that the labels on the Micarta are issued in Westinghouse's name.

I am concerned about the inference contained in Paragraph 2 (a) of Dave's letter, in which he implies that we should terminate investigation on less favorable items. I do think that whatever Mr. Briber does in his evaluation, should yield us conclusive information as to the flame spread characteristics of the Micarta with the special high pigment content surface paper. We may need this information for future development work.

We are glad that you are going to participate in the program, and we shall keep an accurate cost record for subsequent discussions.

I sincerely trust that the procedure of deferring your application until completion of the investigation is satisfactory, as it certainly seems the most logical. Mr. Briber and I are both pursuing this on the basis that you agree.
