Dear Mr. Kull:

In response to your letter of August 30, 1973, please be advised that the above captioned matter was settled at a Formal Newark Workmen's Compensation Hearing before Judge Jaffe on August 1, 1973. As you may be aware, the petitioner alleges an exposure to fumes and paint odors during his 11 year term of employment at the Sherwin Williams Company. The petitioner was represented by Attorney Sidney Swirsky.

The case was settled in the amount of 5% of partial total disability representing 27½ weeks at \$40 per week for a total of \$1100. Counsel fees assessable against the respondent were \$100. Total indemnity payments were therefore \$1200. The case was officially adjudicated on August 1, 1973, however, we still await the formal copy of the signed Judgment. We will make agreed upon payments when the Judgment is received.

I might add that the Formal Judgment rules out any charges against the respondent for either lost time or medical expenses incurred on behalf of this petitioner. I trust that this letter will adequately answer your inquiry of August 30, 1973.
