With respect to the policyholders listed in your memorandum to Mr. A. C. Campbell, most of these companies have been notified in one way or another.

Republic Steel Corporation - Mr. Fitzhugh, Dieter, and I conferred with Mr. Maroney and Mr. Ferguson.

Jones and Laughlin - They have been informed through Mr. McGinnis' visit and my correspondence with Mr. Kelsey.

Evening Bulletin - This company requested a survey about a month ago and it was necessary for me to explain why we were unable to make the survey. Therefore, they have been informed.

Corning Glass Company - As you recall, Mr. Houghton, President of the Company, was informed by Mr. A. C. Campbell.

Johns Manville - I understand this company dropped their insurance.

National Lead Company - We have only made occasional surveys for this company. However, to my knowledge they have not been notified of any discontinuance in service.

Otis Elevator Company - This company requested a survey only a couple of weeks ago and it was necessary for me to explain why the survey could not be carried out.

Hickok Manufacturing Company - I believe we have made a total of two surveys at infrequent intervals. They have not been notified.

Rochester Gas and Electric Company - This company was notified by Mr. Fernald and I believe they mentioned the fact to Mr. Westbay. It was necessary for me to write an explanatory letter.

Mutual Chemical Corporation - This organization now has their own Industrial Hygienist and I doubt whether they will request any further assistance from us.

Columbian Rope Company - As I recall, it was Mr. Perry who suggested to them that we make a survey for the purpose of determining whether their poor experience was due to health hazards. They have never made requests direct to us.

All correspondence from the Groups in Wisconsin was addressed to Mr. Scott and he, in turn, arranged for the surveys. It is possible that he has already notified them. If not, he may wish to handle these plants.

Should any of the Group representatives wish me to accompany them when informing the plants, I shall be pleased to do so.
