Due to the shortage of tin plate, turn plate is now being used as a substitute in the manufacture of gasoline cans. I understand that turn plate contains a certain percentage of lead and it occurs to me that if these containers are used for leaded gasoline there may be an additional hazard in countries where the empty cans are subsequently used for water, edible oil or for cooking purposes.

I do not know whether you have any information in this respect, but would be glad of your views.
