I have enclosed a copy of a subpoena duces tecum requiring Union Carbide to designate an agent to appear at the hearing in this matter and bring the documents listed in the subpoena. You will note that some of the documents which have been subpoenaed are ones which will disclose the amount of shell pressure in the unit at the time that the cooling system was first operated.

I am aware of Lee Rosenthal's contact by Mike Solar and that a lawsuit against Union Carbide now appears to be eminent. We now need to discuss what approach we intend to take toward the ultimate resolution of this matter.
