SUBJECT Asbestos Sampling at B-54

On February 18-19, 1987, two operators from HCC-3 were monitored for asbestos dust exposure as contractors were removing insulation in a pipe rack above their work area. Areas below the removal were roped off and the insulation was kept as wet as possible, captured with plastic sheets and then double bagged for disposal.

The two personal samples taken on February 18 showed 0.01 and 0.02 fibers/cc for the 360 minutes sample time. The samples from February 19 both yielded 0.02 for a 390 sample period. The present TLV for asbestos is 0.2 fibers/cc.
