With this letter you will find our purchase order GPD-9351 which will cover approximately 300 tons of No. 3 Fine Australian Asbestos Fibre to be shipped at approximately 25 tons per month to start upon completion of our present order GPD-8062 and the supplement thereto.

Note that all of the fibre on this new order is to be shipped to the Port of Los Angeles. The shipping papers will be forwarded to us at New York as usual.

At your early convenience we should like to have your acknowledgment, and we would like an expression from you as to the rock content, which we pointed out in our letter of December 7 had run as much as 25%, and we should like your assurance that the quality would be more in line with the fibre received in the first shipments.
