Gentlemen:

In our letter to you of October 8, 1974, we advised that the Department of Labor, Occupational Safety & Health Administration, had issued a Permanent Standard covering Exposure to Vinyl Chloride four days earlier. In accordance with provisions of that Standard covering labeling of packages, the B.F. Goodrich Chemical Company will attach labels to all Geon PVC packages using the prescribed wording:

POLYVINYL CHLORIDE
CONTAINS
VINYL CHLORIDE

VINYL CHLORIDE IS
A CANCER-SUSPECT AGENT

All Geon PVC (including Geon latex) packaged after January 1, 1975 will be labeled. It is anticipated that all such products packaged prior to that date, and not bearing such a label, will be out of our inventories by April 1, 1975. During the first quarter, it is possible that either labeled or non-labeled packages may be shipped.

We will keep you advised of any future developments.
