Reference R. L. Cutler's memo to me of July 19, 1979.

This formula is approved for Cadillac Motor Division C. D. and Z-bodies and the various other divisions for the X-body models for export. Based on these approvals, its use could be expanded to U.S. X-body cars.

If it is our intent to refuse orders for additional quantities of parts over and above what we are presently shipping, then we need a substitute material to take care of their needs.

What have we done to "investigate this formula without lead?" Friction, wear, fade, recovery, water friction, etc.? Get this to me and some samples and I will have our information confirmed.

What about a proposed substitute material?

Please advise what has to be done.
