

1 A Yes, absolutely. There are criteria both
2 for pathologists which are very straightforward, and I
3 am sure the ones that the radiologists use are very
4 straightforward -- and it is just that I don't
5 understand them -- that allow you to say with
6 certainty that a patient has gotten the scarring that
7 you see due to his asbestos exposure.

8 Q The authors also talk about having some
9 cases of mesothelioma in Canada, the United States and
10 in Germany; is that correct?

11 A Yes.

12 Q Are you also familiar with a case report in
13 the literature that talks about a case of mesothelioma
14 written about by Drs. McCaughey and Langer?

15 A Yes, there is a report from 19 -- I believe
16 it is '88, I am not quite sure of that. I remember
17 for sure it was in the Lancet in which they looked at
18 this.

19 Dr. Langer was from this fabled Mount Sinai
20 School of Medicine group that you referred to earlier,
21 and this was a man who had only done brake work, never
