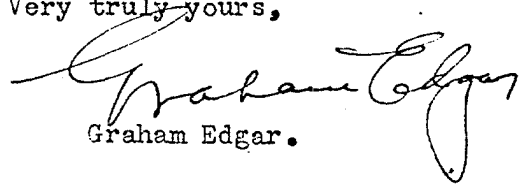

My dear Bob:

The enclosed advertisement reminds me of the fact that during the last couple of years at least two synthetic products of rubber-like characteristics have been developed which are much more resistant to gasoline and oil than ordinary rubber. These are "Neoprene", the synthetic rubber developed by the duPont Company and "Thiokol".

It occurs to me that it might be well to investigate these substances for use in rubber protective equipment in connection with the handling of tetraethyl lead. Conceivably, they might be far superior to ordinary rubber.
