“As the report admits: ‘[t]he data for the Trump Administration’s record so far is just a snapshot and trends vary over time.’ As the former Director for the Office of Regulatory Compliance (now the Office of Civil Enforcement), Mr. Shaeffer knows very well that it can take months or years before a consent decree can be lodged. EIP’s “snapshot” assertions say much more about enforcement actions commenced in the later years of the Obama Administration than it does about actions taken in the beginning of the Trump Administration. Despite this unfair report, EPA is committed to enforcing environmental laws to correct noncompliance and promote cleanup of contaminated sites.” – Patrick Traylor, deputy assistant administrator, EPA Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance.
