Attached is a copy of the rules, regulations and standards for the "Construction Safety Act" (federally assisted construction) which also will be the standards for private construction under the Occupational Safety and Health Act, Public Law 91-596, that is effective April 28, 1971.

Management has determined that we will comply with these standards immediately. Some requirements to be met are subject to our Equipment Department receiving delivery and installing devices such as weight indicators on cranes, hoists, derricks, etc.

See that all of your supervisors familiarize themselves with all of the standards and that each craft supervisor is thoroughly briefed on the sections pertaining to his particular craft. Where we are not in compliance see that immediate action is taken to bring us in compliance.

Further directives will be issued. In the meantime, direct any questions concerning the standards to the Safety Department and questions on interpretation of the law to Stan Rauhut, Legal Department.
