This will confirm our phone conversation of 11/14/56. You advised that no compatibility data for mixtures of resins in the "Dulux 100", "Duco", and "Lucite" systems are available. It was suggested that if no grinding difficulties were encountered, durability panels of universal base formulations be prepared for evaluation in Delaware and Florida.

Subject discussion confirmed findings here, that a CNO alkyd resin would be the best dispersing aid for the three systems. Since it was advised that W-1003 should not be used as an anti-settling agent, material compatible with all three subject systems is necessary. Please advise.
