SUMMARY OF ZINC OXIDE DEPARTMENT OPERATIONS

YEAR 1943

OPERATIONS:

The French retort furnace operated only one 12 retort unit for 118 furnace days during the year in campaigns of about 45 days each. A total of 1,197.5 tons of electrolytic zinc was charged at an average working cost of \$32.766 per ton exclusive of major repairs, depreciation and packing costs, and including the retroactive pay adjustment amounting to \$0.321 per ton. The metal loss was 3.28% for the year on the French Furnace operation.

The Muffle Furnace was operated 183 furnace days producing zinc oxide and 279 days on slab zinc. A total of 2,611.5 tons of scrap was charged for zinc oxide production, and 4,065.4 tons of scrap for slab zinc production. The average working cost was \$24.247 per ton of scrap charged for oxide, exclusive of depreciation, major repairs and packing costs, and including the retroactive pay adjustment amounting to \$0.838 per ton. The average working cost on slab zinc was \$28.873 per ton of scrap charged, exclusive of depreciation, major repairs and packing costs, and including the retroactive pay adjustment amounting to \$0.311 per ton. The metal loss was 1.84% on zinc oxide operations and a gain of 0.98% was shown for slab zinc operations.

The American Process operations consisted of the operation of one six-door unit for the entire year. A total of 1,855.0 tons of zinc-bearing material was treated with a loss of 13.27% for the year. The average working cost was \$37.514 per ton exclusive of depreciation, major repairs and packing costs, and including the retroactive pay adjustment amounting to \$0.522 per ton.

LABOR:

Under date of September 6th, 1943, the National War Labor Board ordered an increase in pay for hourly workers on the following basis:

Rate of 72¢ to be increased 5¢ per hour
Rates of 73¢ to 79¢ to be increased 4¢ per hour
Rates of 80¢ or over to be increased 3¢ per hour

This increase was made retroactive to December 15th, 1942

The number of employees on an hourly basis varied from a minimum of 56 for July to a maximum of 79 in January.

LABOR SHORTAGE

The critical labor shortage presented a serious problem throughout the year. It became necessary to start hiring women late in 1943, and as the labor shortage became more acute, it was necessary to resort to the employment of colored women. By December, 1943 30% of the total operating force was made up of women and 57% of these women were colored. The employment of this type of labor has reduced the efficiency of all operations.

APPROPRIATIONS:

A total of \$768.31 was spent on appropriations in 1943 to construct a concrete dock and wooden bins for the storage of scrap zinc materials.

OPERATING COSTS:

The working cost for the entire plant for the year 1943 was \$42.220 per ton of material charged, exclusive of depreciation and major repairs, and including the retroactive pay adjustment amounting to \$0.453 per ton.

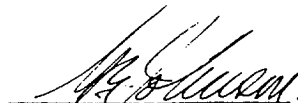
A total of 10,485,978 pounds of zinc oxide and 3,591,614 pounds of zinc slabs were shipped excluding the by-products from the secondary metal operations that were sold.

ZINC MATERIALS PURCHASED:

We purchased 1,505.0 tons of electrolytic zinc at an average cost of 8.279¢ per pound and 6,959.7 tons of secondary metals at an average of 6.536¢ per pound of zinc contained. The East St. Louis prime western zinc price was unchanged for the entire year of 1943 at 8.25¢ per pound.
