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g. AROMATIC HYDROCARBONS, COAL TAR DYES, INTERMEDIATES AND RELATED SUBSTANCES

The numerous aromatic derivatives of the fractionation of tar and petroleum, especially the cyclic nitro- and amido compounds (dye intermediates) as well as many finished products, such as coal tar dyes, represent an important and frequent source of occupational and non-occupational dermatitis and dermatosis, as these products come in contact not only with handlers of these substances in chemical plants and their users in other industrial establishments (textile industry, rubber industry, electrical appliance industry, foodstuff
