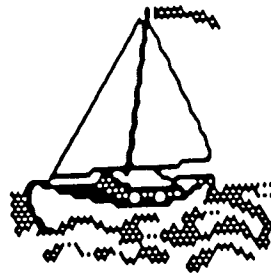
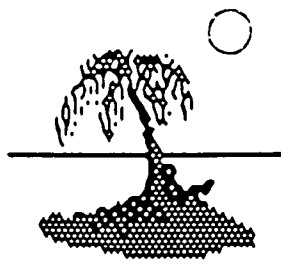

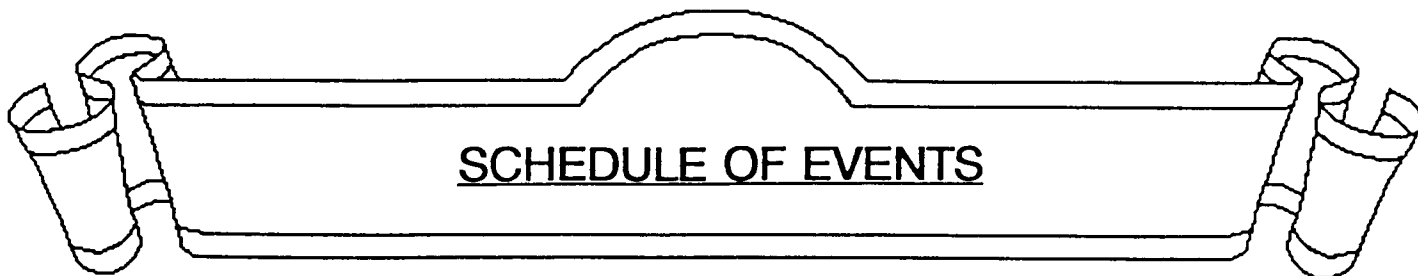
We have also included our new wallet card "Vinyl: We're Glad You Asked" and our rolodex card for VERCE.

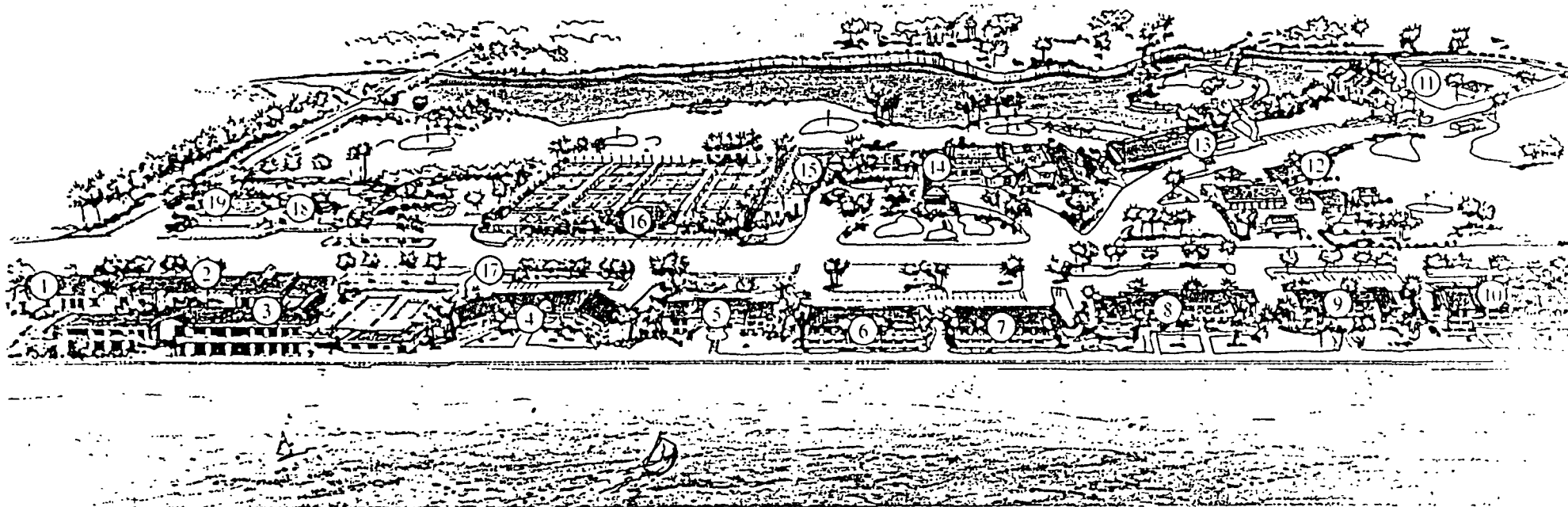

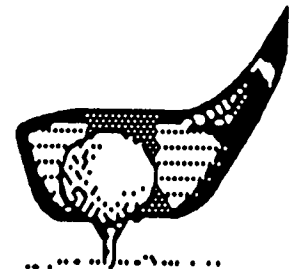
