Pure Colors in Oil are manufactured from dry colors after they have had extensive laboratory tests to prove uniformity of color tinting strength and force. The pigments are double ground on special equipment in pure linseed oil, imparting a fineness that adds to their outstanding quality. Each step in production is watched carefully to assure the user a color that will "set-in" in its paint bases easily, uniformly and free from lumps and granular particles which ordinarily result in streaking.

Each color is furnished in a paste form that disperses quickly in the paint. To those users who reduce their oil color to paste with black and other heavy colors, we recommend the use of linseed oil for exterior paints, and turpentine for flat and semi-gloss bases.

Pure Colors in Oil are economical for the painter because of their strength, their easy mixing, and the convenient "dickinson" cans in which they are packaged.
