

LONDON, Aug. 20 (AP)—The United States will tell its Atlantic pact allies Tuesday they are dragging their feet in the race to rearm against Russia.

Informal sources said this word will be passed to the 12 nation Council of Deputies by its American chairman, Charles M. Spofford, at its second session here.

Spofford, just back from Washington after presiding at the first talks last month, is expected to tell his colleagues that their plans fail to provide enough manpower, ships on the water, production, are too slow and lean too heavily on the United States for money, men and materials.

U.S. on Tone

Spofford told newsmen that he found in Washington "a very great determination that the United States is prepared to do its full part in the speedy buildup of the defense of the North Atlantic area—based on the recognition that the other members are prepared to do their full part."

"Returning now for the second session, we hope to take other concrete steps in that direction," he added.

Immediate job of the deputies is to arm and man western defenses from the Arctic to the Aegean inside the next two years. Four main subjects on their agenda for Tuesday:

Man power: Here the immediate goal is how to train—at least—the combat forces available for defending Europe. Present estimated western strength in Europe is around 14 divisions. The idea is to have a central western army based in Europe.

British, French Plans

Money. The French have suggested financing the overall rearmament program by setting up a pool to which each nation would contribute proportionately. Economically weak nations would get more help than economically strong nations. The British have a counter plan which they base on "fair shares for all." It's still secret.

Arms. The problem is to get production wheels rolling at once, without too greatly damaging individual economic recovery programs. All agree sacrifices by individual nations are inevitable. Few agree on the extent to which extra burdens should be undertaken.

Organization. This includes setting up an international staff and providing for much closer coordination between the participating several agencies.

The American argument is that some European nations fail sufficiently to grasp the urgency of the international situation.

Korea, Indo-China Hoags

French insistence, for instance, that the United States should send a minimum of six divisions to be based permanently in Europe is held to leave out of account the American effort in Korea.

The French counter that by pointing to their burden in strife-torn Indo-China where 160,000 troops are trying to beat down a Red-led national revolutionary movement.

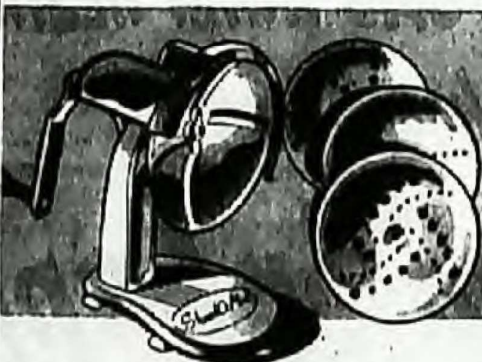
