A decision is requested on issuing a patent on the subject application. Six claims (attached) were allowed on May 25, 1970. The application has not been filed in foreign countries.

The claims refer to a process for applying a textured coating to a metal substrate. The process has been used to apply a finish to automobile trunks.

There is currently no commercial activity in this area, however, the product has potential future commercial value.

The Flint R & D Laboratory feels this application should issue. Request is made for approval to pay the required fee of \$110 in order that the patent may issue.
