I understand that the rule was sent to OMB but OMB sent the rule back to Pruitt's team asking for a "regulatory impact analysis" that pertains to the rule's fiscal impact, is that correct?

Sources who are in the glider truck industry inform me that Pruitt's rule change may not go into effect for another 6 months, is that accurate? If not, then can you tell me how long it will take for this process to play out before the rule goes into effect?

What the next steps -- does the rule go back to OMB?
