My dear Dr. White:

Your letter of the 18th instant has arrived before Dr. Drinker's return to the city, and I am therefore making another endeavor to give you the information you want. The Journal of Industrial Hygiene, of which Dr. Drinker is the Managing Editor, contains an Abstract Section which covers all the leading scientific journals and publications. The subject index at the end of each volume lists the articles abstracted, and those on lead are under the caption Lead as follows:
