Legacy, located in Jefferson, LA, operates an emergency response remediation company and provides industrial cleaning services. Legacy provides natural disaster response, environmental spill response, search and rescue, hydro-blasting, and waste brokerage services. Legacy also operates industrial cleaning operations, where they clean crude and chemical storage tanks, vessel and barge tanks. When Legacy responds to a spill clean-up, a third party is typically contracted to pick up the contained waste and transport it for disposal. Waste generated from tank cleanings is either left with the customer on site or picked up by a waste transporter immediately. The Jefferson Legacy location serves as an office space for accounting and management, and the environmental services and equipment are not run out of this location. Therefore, this location of Legacy is not registered with the EPA. Following the opening conference, the inspection team proceeded to close out as there was no waste or field operations conducted at this site. The inspection team did not observe any areas of concern (AOCs) at the time of the inspection. However, further EPA review may change or add to their potential AOCs. A closing conference was conducted at approximately 9:15 AM with Legacy personnel.
