

- I. Voluntary quits for personal reasons on April 9, 1974.
- II. Our first notice of any claim which would be causally related was when we received notice that a claim was filed. No mention to her employer that she had these symptoms two months earlier, or that she was suffering from this condition for over a year as she had told Dr. Crumer.
- III. Dr. Crumer diagnosed Rhinitis and irritation conjunctivitis due to chemicals at work. This diagnosis was made on the basis of our examination by him.
- IV. Since she had not worked for us or been exposed to chemicals for over a year ^{she also} we questioned any condition which she might be suffering from at the present to her exposure over a year $\frac{1}{2}$ ago. We had her examined by Robert Erichman an E.A.R., N.S.E., and Throat Specialist — Dr. Erichman concludes that
- "In my opinion

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she has a nervous condition not related to her occupation which affects her eyes & nose. It also indicates that she may have other allergies which may affect or cause this condition.

We think it very important to note that Dr Cramer makes the observation that - If she stayed away from these chemicals then her condition cleared - However she has not been exposed but has recently developed another occurrence as late as 9-13-85.

For these reasons we do not believe her present condition is the direct result of some exposure several years ago.
