This meeting is to discuss the Pennsylvania Air Pollution Control Commission's action taken on April 25, 1967 in adopting a tentative air quality standard for lead of 5 micrograms per cubic meter of air. This meeting will be attended by legal representatives of some of our members who will advise us.

The meeting will also discuss the preparation of an LIA statement to be given before the meeting of the Montana State Air Pollution Control Commission on May 26, 1967. The Montana meeting will be an open hearing on the question of adopting, among other things, an air quality standard for lead of 5 micrograms per cubic meter of air averaged over twenty-four hours.

Please be prepared to discuss in detail these questions and to help in the preparation of statements for both commissions. It would be helpful if you let us know whether or not you can attend.
