Dear Mr. Jones:

Because of the potential dust problem with Asbestos, we confirm that polyethylene liners can be placed in the 50 pound burlap bags used for Hooker #3 Asbestos Fiber. Because of the additional bagging time required, there is an additional charge of \$5.00 per ton.

This package can be unitized on special 52" x 52" wooden pallets with the application of steel bands, at a charge of \$5.00 for the pallet strapping and additional labor.

It is emphasized, the arrival condition of a palletized rail car may not be completely satisfactory as the Asbestos tends to settle enroute and result in some loose straps.

Attached is a copy of a letter from Mr. H.X. Mesler, Jr., our Safety Manager, to Mr. A.H. Murphy in your Safety Department, regarding Asbestos dust. We hope this information is helpful.
