- * \$350-\$375 million new investment
- * 65 new permanent jobs created by the investment
- * Total employment at the site will be 335 after new investment completed
- * 400 contractors are working to construct the new investment
- * New investment slated to be online and producing product in Sept. 2018
- * Air-conditioned building could accommodate a dais and at least 200 people.
- * Site leadership and plant personnel were/are pro-President Trump
