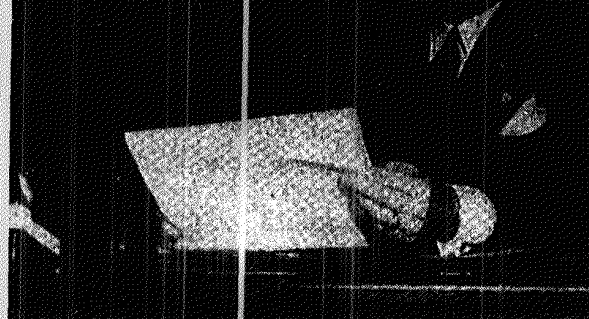

King City Planes Forced Down

Heavy Oklahoma Rains Ground Craft Coming From Kansas

OKLAHOMA CITY, April 29.
—Eighteen U. S. army planes,
being ferried from Wichita,
Kans., to King City, Calif., were
forced down today by heavy
rain at widely scattered fields
in Oklahoma.

Eight of the planes, described
as Stearman PT-17s, landed at an
emergency field near Guthrie.
Five others came down at the
Oklahoma City airbase, three at
the Clinton field near Yukon
and two at Fort Sill.

All landed without mishap and
would remain until the weather
cleared, airport officials said.
The group is under command of
Lieut. Walter Hazelwood.

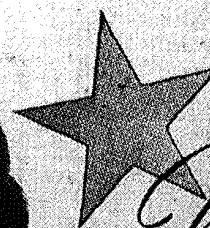
