We will be presenting the ASD views on the REACH PFAS restriction proposal at a meeting organized by CEFIC (Chemical Industry Association) together with DG GROW and other downstream users of PFAS. As you might know the current PFAS restriction proposal has not taken into account the specificities of the aviation sector and as such put at risk aviation safety as well as many technologies needed for decarbonization.
