F. Goodrich in LaPorte, Texas is a product and not a hazardous waste, and thus does not fall under the jurisdiction of the Louisiana Hazardous Waste Regulations (LHWR). I encourage you to contact the Texas Water Commission to determine the regulatory status of this material under the State of Texas' regulations.
