Dear Mr. Finsterbusch:

The Ethyl Corporation requests the services of Stone & Webster Engineering Corporation in connection with the erection of new ethylene dichloride manufacturing facilities at its Baton Rouge, Louisiana, Plant. We wish Stone & Webster to perform the construction work only for this expansion.

We propose that the foregoing work be carried out in accordance with Part II - Design and Construction - of Term Contract between us, dated May 29, 1945. Since your Company is to perform the construction work only, this will be a Class "C" Project and will carry a fee of six and one-quarter per cent (estimated completed cost one hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars) of the "Cost of the Work" as same is defined in the Term Contract.

Will you kindly see that insurance coverage for the work is in accordance with the terms and conditions stipulated by Mr. Southwick for insurance coverage on work to be performed by Stone & Webster for Ethyl's account.
