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PVC PIPE TAPPING VIDEO AVAILABLE

WAYNE, New Jersey, November 30, 1990 -- A new 15-minute video program which directs construction field crews on the proper procedures for tapping PVC pressure pipe is available from Uni-Bell PVC Pipe Association.
