Dear Mr. Deemer:

We would be pleased to train your employees on occupational health measurements in July at your Adelphin, MD training school. Attached is a proposed schedule for a two-day training course and six instruction booklets for the students. The following is a list of procedural details to expedite the training:

Students

1. Please distribute the instruction booklets, "Fundamentals of Industrial Hygiene Measurements for Operating Telephone Companies", to all students. They should read the introduction section for all the laboratories prior to attending the course. Have them bring the booklets with them to the class.
2. Each student will need a watch and a calculator for timing samples and calculating results.
3. Each student will need appropriate personal protective equipment (hardhats, safety glasses, etc.), required at the plant training school. Please let me know your requirements.

Location

1. Please let me know the location of a nearby hotel. If you are making arrangements for the students, please reserve two rooms for instructors.
2. We will require one classroom for training with tables for students, a 35 mm slide projector and screen, and a blackboard or easel.
3. Let me know the name and address of a contact at the training school for shipping materials required for teaching, and for discussing lead wiping measurements.
