You have told us that Monsanto has discontinued Pydraul AC and is now marketing Pydraul AC-A, the reason being that the Pydraul AC-A is less toxic than the AC.

As you know we are using the Pydraul for vacuum pump lubrication discharging to the atmosphere. The big question is just how toxic is the AC-A compared to the AC and to the competing brands of phosphate esters? Can we safely use these products from the pollution standpoint in our vacuum pumps?

We would appreciate any information Monsanto has available concerning the toxicity of these lubricants and their breakdown products.
