I have received a copy of your letter dated October 17 concerning Therminol to answer. There are several of these Therminol fluids but the odds are the requesting company in New Jersey is talking about Therminol FR-1.

Therminol FR-1 is principally chlorinated biphenyl with 42% chlorination by weight. We have marketed these materials for many years in this form and have found that most users have had little difficulty if the system is tight and has no leaks.

I have enclosed a copy of a statement concerning the toxicity and safe handling of this product that we supply customers and if I can be of any further help, please let me know.
