Subject: MSDS Update for Pass Car Linings

Enclosed are updated copies of MSDS that you requested. The various product lines that we sell for Pass car (and light truck) use are covered by 7 MSDS's labeled as follows:

- 1) Semi-met Disc pads
- 2) Semi-met Disc Pad - with Asbestos Backing
- 3) Organic Disc Pad - Asbestos

- 4) Organic Segment - Asbestos Free
- 5) " " " " - Asbestos

- 6) Flexible Segment - Asbestos Free
- 7) Flexible Segment - Asbestos

A couple of notes in how the documents relate to the product. Each MSDS lists the formulas covered as a 2-letter code on Page 1. These are listed under EDGE CODE or FORMULA ID. The corresponding 2 letters are on the edge of each brake lining you receive that you can relate to the proper MSDS. Also, the MSDS for Asbestos-free products have a precautionary attachment regarding asbestos dust even though the lining we send you does not contain any. That is to alert you to possible problems of the lining **coming off**.
