Sir:

Reference is made to previous correspondence in which you urged an extension of the 3-year period prescribed in Section 313 (h), Tariff Act of 1930, for the exportation of drawback merchandise.

On April 1, 1935, the President issued a proclamation authorizing the Secretary of the Treasury to extend the 3-year period in certain cases. An extension in these cases is being granted by the Secretary of the Treasury in the form of a Treasury Decision, which also contains instructions to collectors of customs in the matter. This decision will be published in an early issue of the weekly Treasury Decisions for the information of all concerned. An advance copy is inclosed for your information.
