Form OD-4 has been filed by the claimant on which he states he is
 from a lung condition which is the result of an occupational disease
 d in the course of his employment with the named employer. That his
 worked was July 29, 1960.

The employer has submitted a letter in which they state that after
 claimant did not work for them in Ohio. That he worked either in West
 here we reported and paid, or Pennsylvania where they were privately
 d paid premiums accordingly. They further states that from 1957 to
 3 the claimant worked in West Virginia and from May 16, 1960 through
 60 he worked in Pennsylvania. They further state they had no mutual
 with the claimant to be bound by the Workmen's Compensation Law of any
 state. The employer has submitted wages from January 1, 1953 to July

The claimant in his affidavit states that he has been a resident
 of Ohio continuously from 1915 to date. That from 1915 to 1943 he
 ent of Youngstown, Ohio, and from 1943 to date he has been a resident
 Ohio.

The claimant further states that he first started working in the
 de in 1925 when he started working for the Smith Faris Company,
 Ohio and remained in their employ until 1931. That he then became
 the Asbestos Service Company, Youngstown, Ohio in 1933 and remained
 boy until 1942. That the work performed for these two employers
 exclusively in Ohio.

The claimant further states that in 1942 until 1952 he was employed
 ansville Company and since 1952 has been employed by the Philip Carey
 Company.

The claimant further states that in 1950 to 1952 the vast majority
 s performed in Ohio. That in 1953 approximately 30 weeks were spent
 1954 approximately 40 weeks were spent in Ohio. He further states
 e spent the entire year in Ohio. He further states that from late
 Spring of 1956 he worked exclusively in Ohio. However, there were
 not working due to lack of work.

he claimant further states that his last exposure in Ohio occurred
 Steel Corporation, Youngstown, Ohio in 1957.
