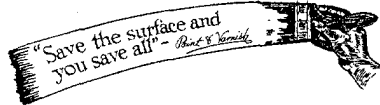

Gentlemen:

-Attention Henry S. Thompson.-

We have your communication of March 15th in answer to ours of the 23rd ultimo respecting the division of expenses incident to the investigation by the Harvard Medical School of lead poisoning.

Our records disclose that in 1921 we paid you \$3,141.14. In 1922 we can find no record of a payment to you by this company although it is extremely possible that the Hammar Bros. White Lead Company, which we own and which is located in E. St. Louis, Ill., sent you some money. If they did not, we will be most pleased to send you a check for the 1922 amount as it has been divided between ourselves and the National Lead Company. We understood that on December 8th you stated you had received \$15,658.86 of the \$17,000.00 which was the stipulated amount for the year 1922, which would leave only \$1,341.14 remaining. Will you please look up your record of December 8th to the National Lead Company and ascertain just what proportion of the amount you stated you had received had been paid by the different companies. Your early attention to this matter would be most appreciated.
