"Pending Results"

Recently Resin Plant Quality Control has had to report certain "pending" test results for Burlington suspension production, as you pointed out in the attached memo.

This has been necessary for the following reasons:

1. Dry Blend

The heat transfer oil in the Brabender Plasticorder required changing. Until this was accomplished and the instrument recalibrated to our control standard, dry blend results were "pending". Since 2/11/69 dry blend results have been reported.

2. Light Absorbance

The power unit to the reflectance attachment on the Spectronic 20 requires replacement. Until this replacement is received, light absorbance test result readings will be "pending". However, in the interim pressed discs of copolymer production lots are being compared visually to a control and graded on a go, no-go basis.
