SUBJECT: J-M Complaint PHP-21-9, Dated 12/28/62, Star Building Specialties

The subject complaint has just been received along with the reply of the plant dated January 7.

It is noticed that this material was purchased and shipped on 8/17/62 and then over four months (19 weeks) later the salesman submits a report of complaint indicating a late delivery and the fact that the dealer paid \$10.00 waiting time to his crew. We cannot consider complaints such as these in any sense of the word. If the trucker out of the Wilmington Plant is not making the time deliveries, it should be brought to the attention of the Plant Manager within a day or two, if not the same day so that corrective measures can be taken to prevent its recurrence.

Any payment made on the basis of such a delayed report cannot be allowed on the part of Bestwall to J-M.
