In my letter of August 1, 1968, I requested the names of workers exposed to asbestos. Several physicians since then have asked whether workers exposed sporadically should be included in the list.

We would like to include only those exposed regularly for at least eight hours per month, such as ladders, pipecoverers, insulators, and workers in areas contaminated with asbestos dust. Do not include workers exposed irregularly for short periods of time.

We have none in this category.
