Subject: Asbestos

The sample of bulk pipe insulation submitted by you to our Industrial Hygiene Lab was analyzed for asbestos content. The sample was forwarded to Environmental Research Group (ERG) in Ann Arbor for analysis by polarized light microscopy. The sample contained 12 percent chrysotile. Amosite was not detected at a one percent concentration.

Pipe fitters and pipe coverers and other skilled trades personnel who might be exposed to dust from this pipe valve insulation obtained from the plant's mechanical room must be informed that the material contains asbestos. Compliance with Company industrial hygiene guidelines and OSHA standards for asbestos must be met.
