

PLANT MILLER

HISTORY

- * Construction began in 1973
- * The four units went into commercial production between 1978 and 1991

CAPACITY/ GENERATION

- * 2,916 MWs of capacity
- * 18,193,039 MWhs of net generation in 2016
- * Produces enough energy to serve about 1 million homes
- * In 2013 and 2015 ranked first among our nation's coal plants in net generation
- * World class availability when compared to peers

FUEL

- * Economically priced low-sulfur Powder River Basin coal
- * Approximately 10 million tons burned annually
- * 650 train loads per year

ENVIRONMENTAL ENHANCEMENTS

- * Invested \$1.6 billion in environmental controls to comply with EPA regulations
- * These controls include:
 - Electrostatic precipitators
 - Cooling towers
 - Selective catalytic reduction
 - Flue gas desulfurization
 - Mercury removal systems
- * Projected to spend an additional \$500 million on future EPA land and water regulations

WORKFORCE/ ECONOMIC IMPACT

- * 365 full-time employees
- * 210 of the full-time employees are part of the IBEW union
- * More than 2,700 hours of community service by employees in 2016
- * \$34.5 million annually in labor including overtime
- * \$127.3 million annually in contract labor
- * Over \$12 million in property taxes paid annually
