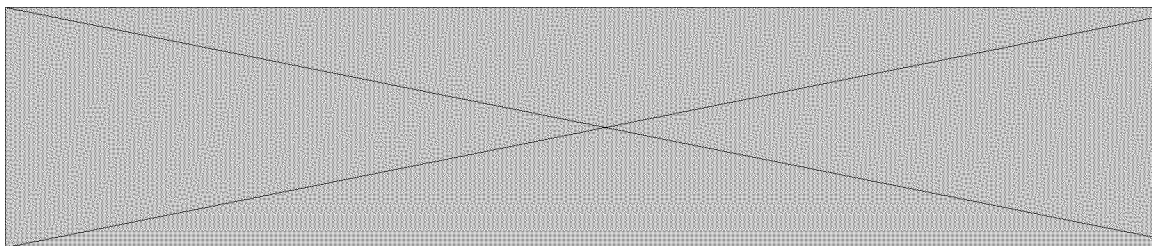

Now in its seventh year, the Climate Leadership Awards provide national recognition for exemplary corporate, organizational, and individual leadership in response to climate change. The U.S Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) co-sponsors the awards in partnership with the Center for Climate and Energy Solutions (C2ES) and The Climate Registry (TCR).

Choose From Six Award Categories

The 2018 Climate Leadership Awards will honor recipients across six categories. Please [contact us](#) to answer your questions about specific criteria. Here are a few helpful hints:

- If your organization has recently set an entity-wide greenhouse gas (GHG) reduction goal (publicly announced after Jan. 1, 2015), you may be eligible for an [Excellence in Greenhouse Gas Management \(Goal Setting\) Certificate](#)
- If your organization has recently (since Jan. 1, 2014) achieved an entity-wide GHG reduction goal, you may be eligible for an [Excellence in Greenhouse Gas Management \(Goal Achievement\) Award](#)
- If your organization is in the middle of a goal period (and/or has already been recognized for setting a GHG reduction goal), and continues to pursue mitigation projects, stakeholder engagement, and climate resilience, you may be eligible for an [Organizational Leadership Award](#)
- If your organization is focused on supply chain management and sustainable procurement (and leading by example, already has a GHG reduction goal), you may be eligible for a [Supply Chain Leadership Award](#)
- If your organization has a climate champion worthy of recognition, nominate them for an [Individual Leadership Award](#)
- If your organization is collaborating with external stakeholders or partners to implement climate mitigation and/or adaptation and resilience initiatives (category does not require GHG reduction goal or third-party verification), you may be eligible for an [Innovative Partnership Certificate](#)
