Although we have approximately 3 to 4 weeks' supply of the lead - raw materials at New Orleans, we will nevertheless switch immediately over to the new formula and will utilize the old raw materials in other productions.

From all that has transpired with regard to this problem during the past 3 years, it appears that this problem may well be resolved now with these changes going into effect.
