SUMMARY OF PROJECT:

The purpose of this work unit is to screen carbamates, fungicides, insect repellents, herbicides and polychloro biphenyls for possible teratogenic effects.

The mosquitofish, "Gambusia affinis" will be used as a test animal. Groups of mosquitofish containing both male and female subjects will be fed formulations of the above compounds through their diet both alone and in combination. Whole, cleasre specimens of the resulting progeny will be examined for anomalies and histological sections will be evaluated.

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
