Dear Matt:

I am enclosing copies of the following documents I have located based on meetings with various personnel (and trust you will identify these documents or use them as appropriate in answering Interrogatories):

1. Pages referring to asbestos from a book titled Chemical Hazards of the Workplace. This book was located in our Medical Department and was likely not used by Engineering, Manufacturing, etc.
2. A 9/23/86 Standards Memorandum (numbered .0036) directing replacement of asbestos brake materials with non-asbestos materials. All individuals identified in this Memorandum are no longer with the Company. Please note that this is the Standards Memorandum identified in one of the November 11, 1986 handwritten memos I sent you some time ago. In that sense we have closed the loop on some of this.
3. Three SCAN PAC brochures identifying some of the materials (asbestos-containing and non-asbestos containing) referred to in the 1986 Memorandum. I believe "AF" stands for "asbestos-free". Please note the Caution wording at Page 11 of the brochure identifying asbestos products.
4. Copies of relevant pages from an internal "Standards" book. The sections provided cover "Friction Materials" used in some of our products. The earliest I could locate dates to February 1959. The Friction Materials standards were
