A. TECHNICAL PROJECTS

1. GEORGIA- PACIFIC / ETHYL

The customer has replied to our letter to the effect that their test method was the same as that used in Bridgewater. We therefore have no explanation for the gross difference in results obtained, other than to conclude that the test is inherently irreproducible. We will discuss the reproducibility of the test with Bridgewater Tech. Service.

2. WAXED EXTRUDATES

The second round of trials on the Bepex Extructor is scheduled for the week of July 9 in Santa Rosa, Ca. Bepex has indicated that if the equipment proves suitable, they could toll - produce for us on an interim basis in Minneapolis, Mn.

3. PPG

PPG's request for a sample of Lead Cyanamid has been put on hold at the request of R. F. Anderson.

4. PACKARD ELECTRIC

We have begun investigating the feasibility of instituting a Statistical Process Control System at the request of this customer.
