NOTE TO FILE

On 2/17/61 Mr. Edwards phoned and thanked me for my letter of February 14. He said the only ingredients we use in our Careytemp which is toxic is the asbestos fibre, and he asked that we furnish him the amount of fibre used in our formulation, either by weight or by volume.

He said the workmen had been sawing the material in a confined unventilated area, using no masks nor a dust collector on the saw. He said the complainants were our own contract department workers acting through the Indianapolis Local.
